Learning Words and Playing on Swings and Slides As your child . . .

- > climbs up the ladder on the slide, count the stairs.
- > sits on the top of the slide waiting to come down, count "1-2-3-Go!"
- > reaches the bottom of the slide, ask them if they want to go another time by saying, "More? More slide?"
- > climbs up the ladder, say, "up, up, up."
- > zooms down the slide, say, "down whee!"
- > swings on the swing, say "back and forth, back and forth, (name) goes back and forth."
- > swings up and back, say "up and down, up and down"
- > swings, count the times is forward or backward
- > toss a ball toward the child and have him try to kick it as they swing - say, "kick" each time she kicks it
- swings back and forth, sing "back and forth, back and forth, (name) is swinging back and forth" make up a tune
